
Self-guided lessons for teachers and parents to share with students, to maximize learning at home for narrative, expository and essay writing

Author of 150 fiction and non-fiction titles, Sigmund Brouwer has presented his *Rock and Roll Literacy Show* over the last 25 years to more than 1,000,000 students in schools across North America. In the *Academy for Writers* curriculum, he delivers a series of lively and entertaining video each about 10 minutes long, with accompanying writing activities for students, and a guide for parents to support and interact with their children.

The program consists of four parts of seven lessons each. The first three parts cover the secrets of a good story, ways to making writing powerful to deliver that story, and a unique and effective approach to the editing and revising process. The fourth part leads students through the process of creating a complete short story that parents will love.
