

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE NO. 434

THE ROLE OF THE ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT-FAITH DEVELOPMENT AND DIVISION SUPPORT

Background

The Associate Superintendent-Faith Development and Division Support is responsible to the Superintendent. It is intended that the Associate Superintendent - Faith Development and Division Support will be sufficiently informed with respect to all aspects of the school system to be able to assume the functions of the Superintendent in his or her absence. The Associate Superintendent-Personnel is required to attend all Board meetings. The functions of these areas will include, but are not restricted to, the following:

Procedures

The Associate Superintendent – Faith Development and Division Support is expected to supervise and take responsibility in all areas related to faith development and supplemental duties for the Division. The functions of these areas will include, but are not restricted to, the following:

- 1. Promoting Catholicity within the Division;
- 2. Research and Innovation;
 - a) New programs
 - b) Pilot projects
 - c) Special studies
- 3. Supervise and oversee the activities of:
 - a) Faith development opportunities for all Division staff and Trustees
 - b) Mentorship program planning, implementation and evaluation
 - c) Stakeholder input
 - d) Communications Department
- 4. Program Development
 - a) First Nations Metis Inuit (FNMI) Support Team
 - b) Outreach alternative programs (eg. St. Gabriel Cyber School)
 - c) Social Justice Initiatives
 - d) Leadership Pool Professional Development, recruitment and Zone 4 Aspiring Leaders program
 - e) Zone 4 Leadership Development Program
 - f) Division Youth Ministry Program

- g) International education initiatives involving students and staff, including International Education Services Program
- h) Learning Commons development
- i) Summer reading program
- j) Division and School Improvement Plan Coordination
- 5. Pupil Services
 - a) Parent concerns/communication
 - b) Liaison with outside agencies
 - c) Attendance
 - d) Discipline
 - e) Emergency Preparedness Planning
- 6. Those duties and responsibilities as assigned by the Superintendent.

Note: These responsibilities are subject to change depending on the needs of the Division. Discussion will be held with the Associate Superintendent - Faith Development and Division Support regarding such changes, but the Division retains the right to restructure or reassign duties.
