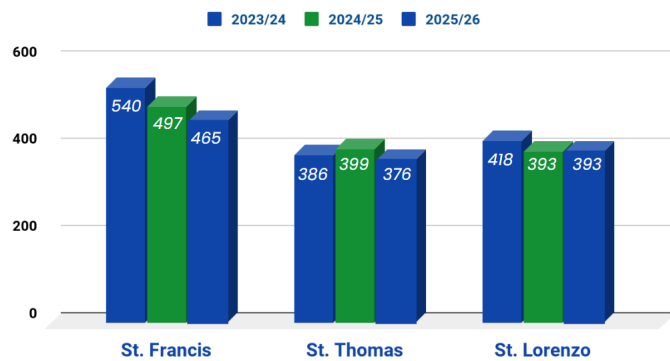

Option 1 Population Breakdown

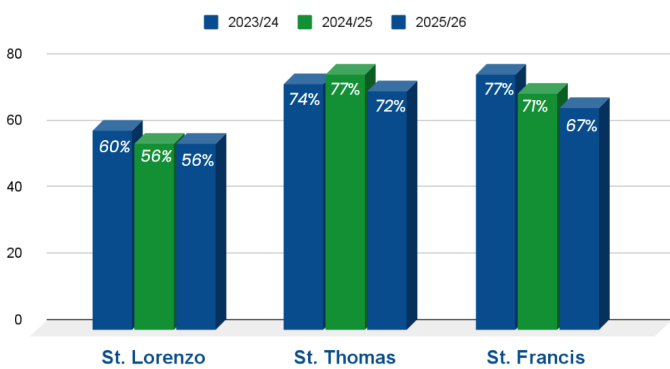

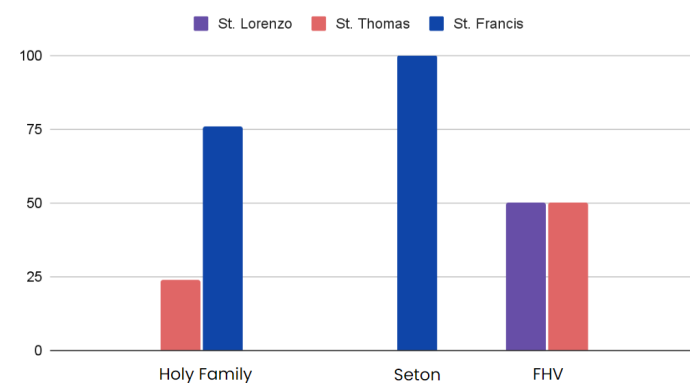

Elementary Transition Breakdown (Option 1)



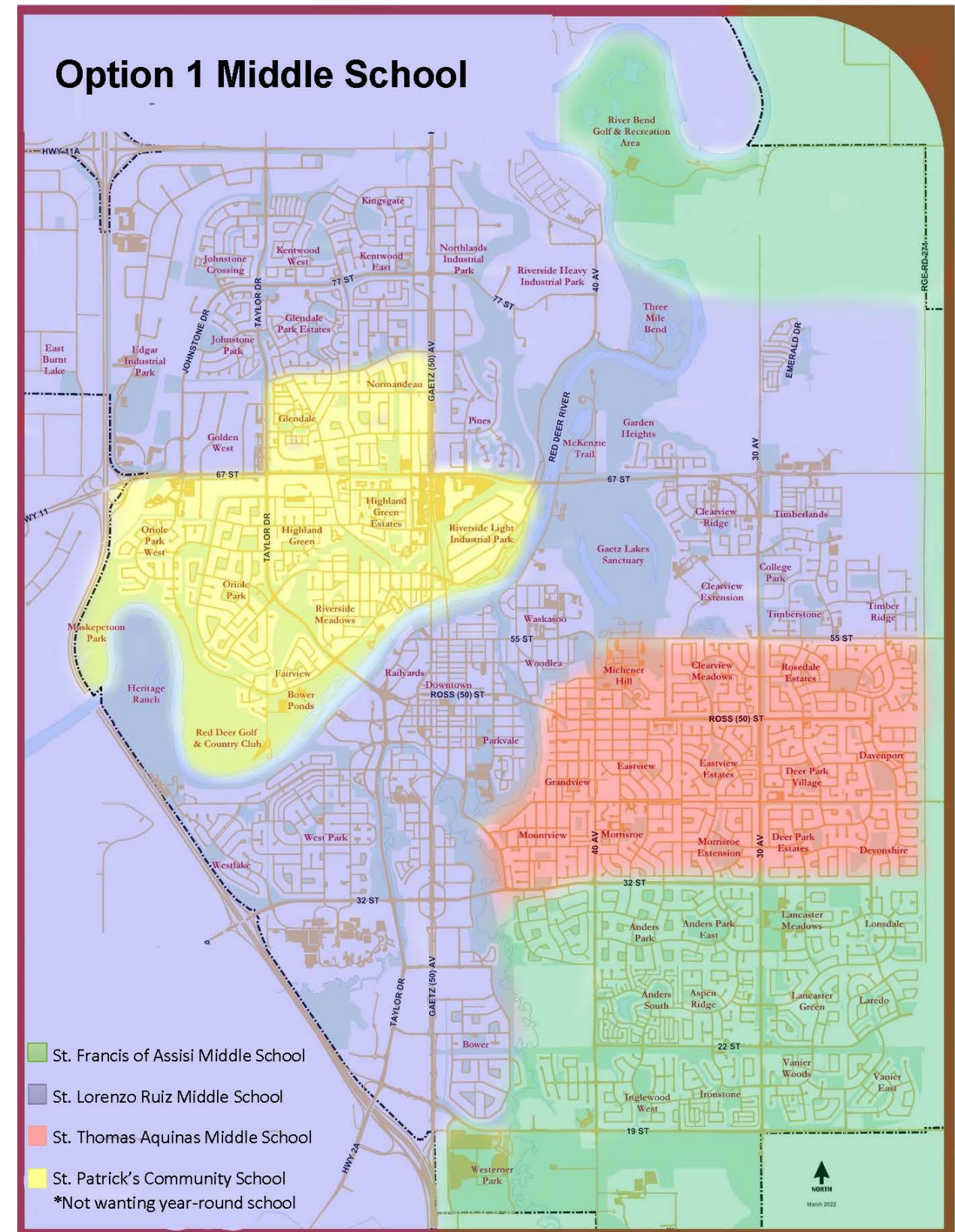
PROS:

- Keeping St. Francis and St. Thomas boundaries as close as possible to existing.
- Provides St. Lorenzo a higher utilization rate.
- Keeping together as many southside schools as possible.

CONS:

- Splitting groups (Holy Family and Father Henri Voisin).
- Busing south RD to St. Lorenzo.
- Maryview capacity concerns.
- St. Thomas Aquinas is a restricted boundary without growth.
- Not equal splitting (see Holy Family).
- St. Francis may not sustain continued growth before another middle school.

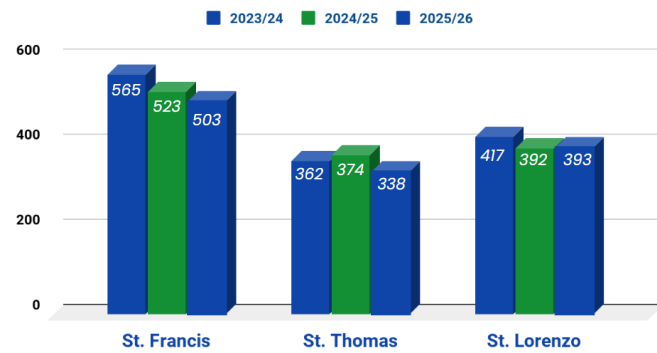

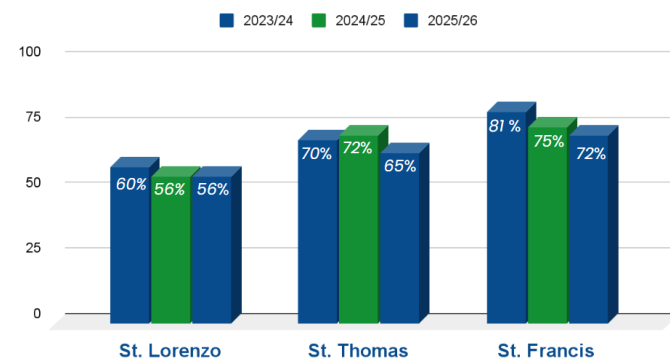

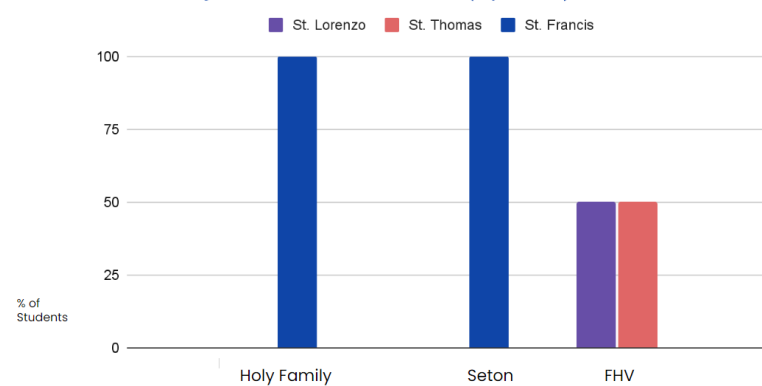
Option 2 Population Breakdown

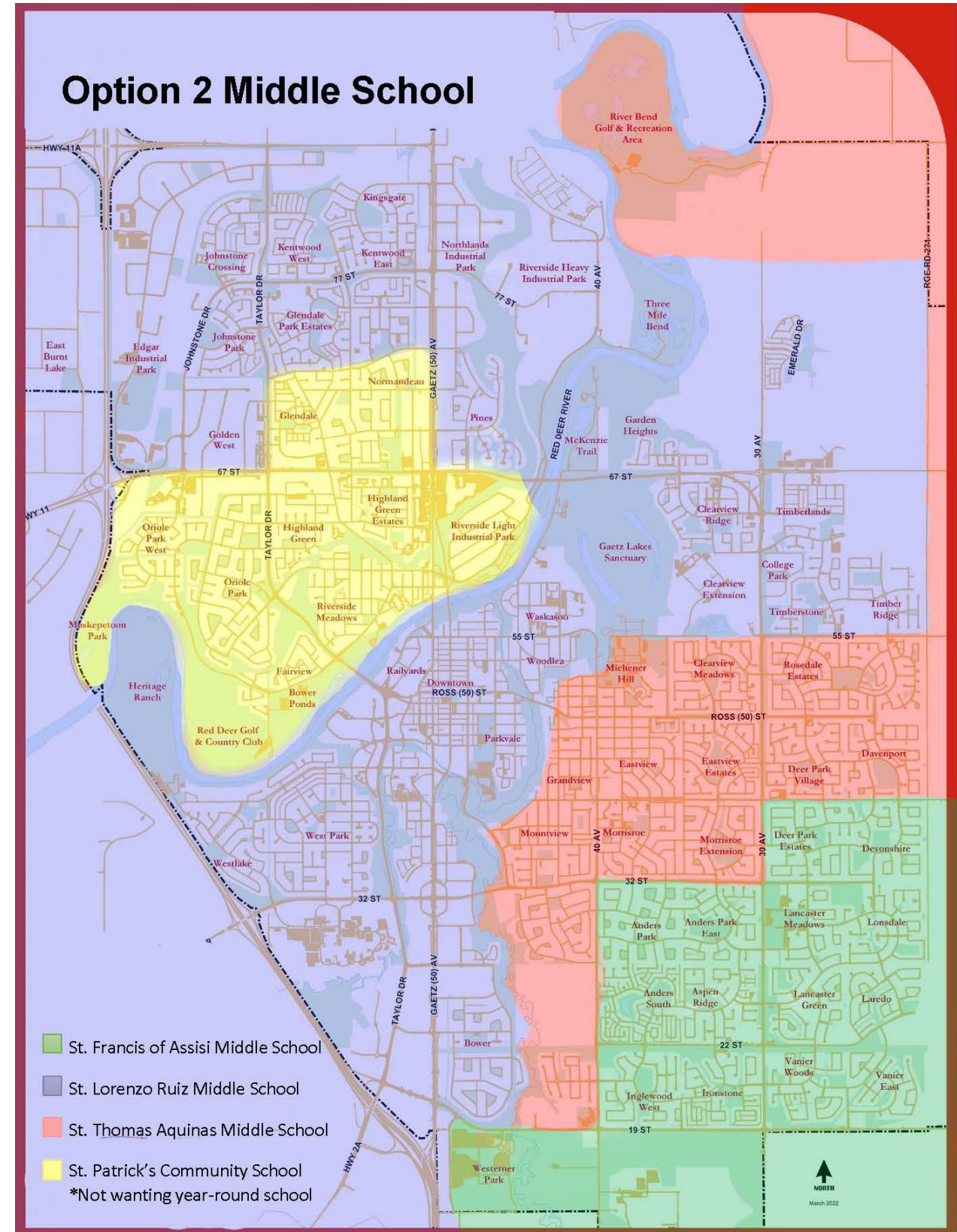
PROS:

- Southbrook perception of "leapfrogging" St. Elizabeth Seton and St. Francis.

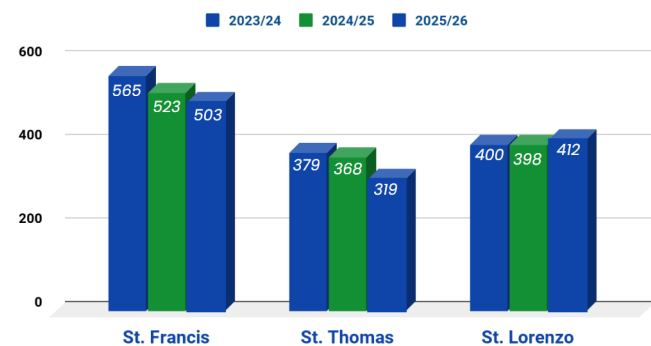

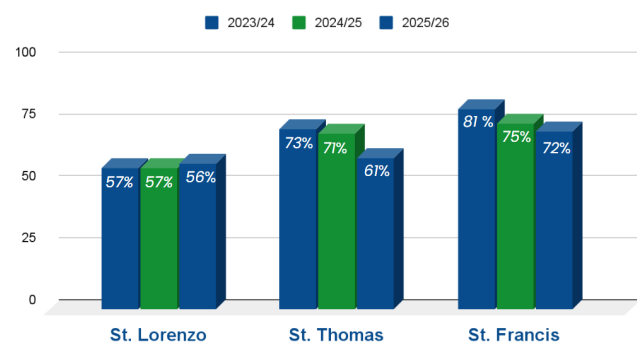

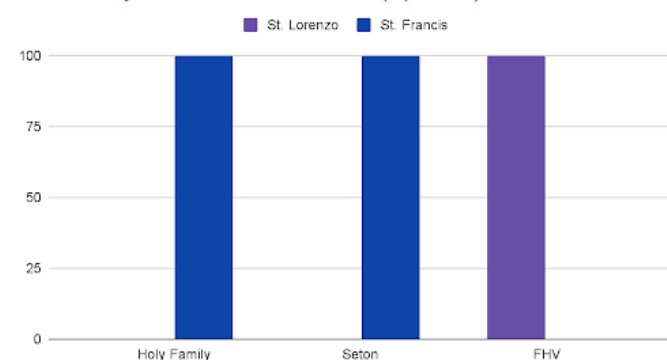
Option 3 Population Breakdown

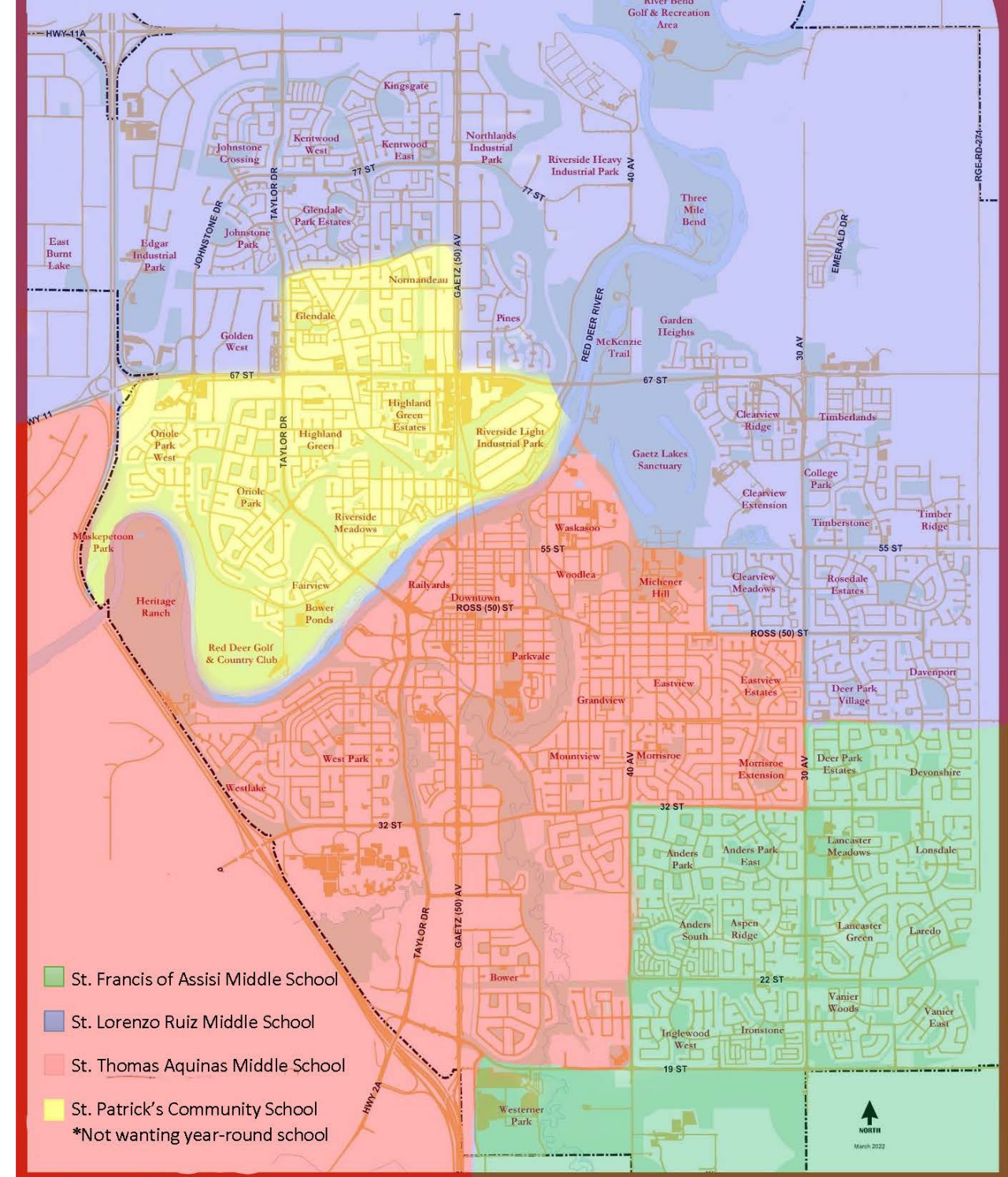
PROS:

- Longer ride times from Deer Park and Rosedale to St. Lorenzo.

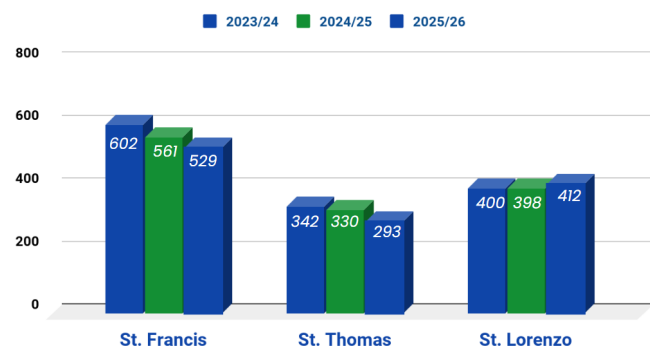

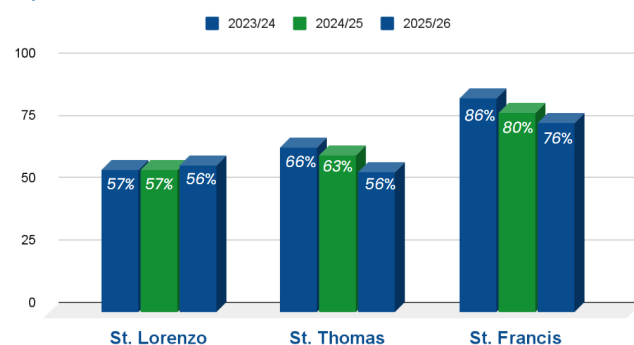

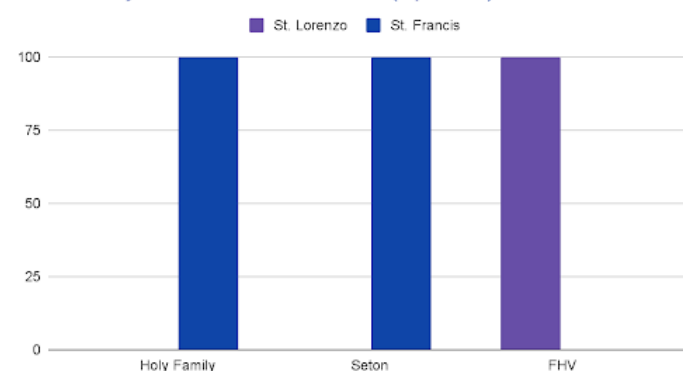
Option 4 Population Breakdown

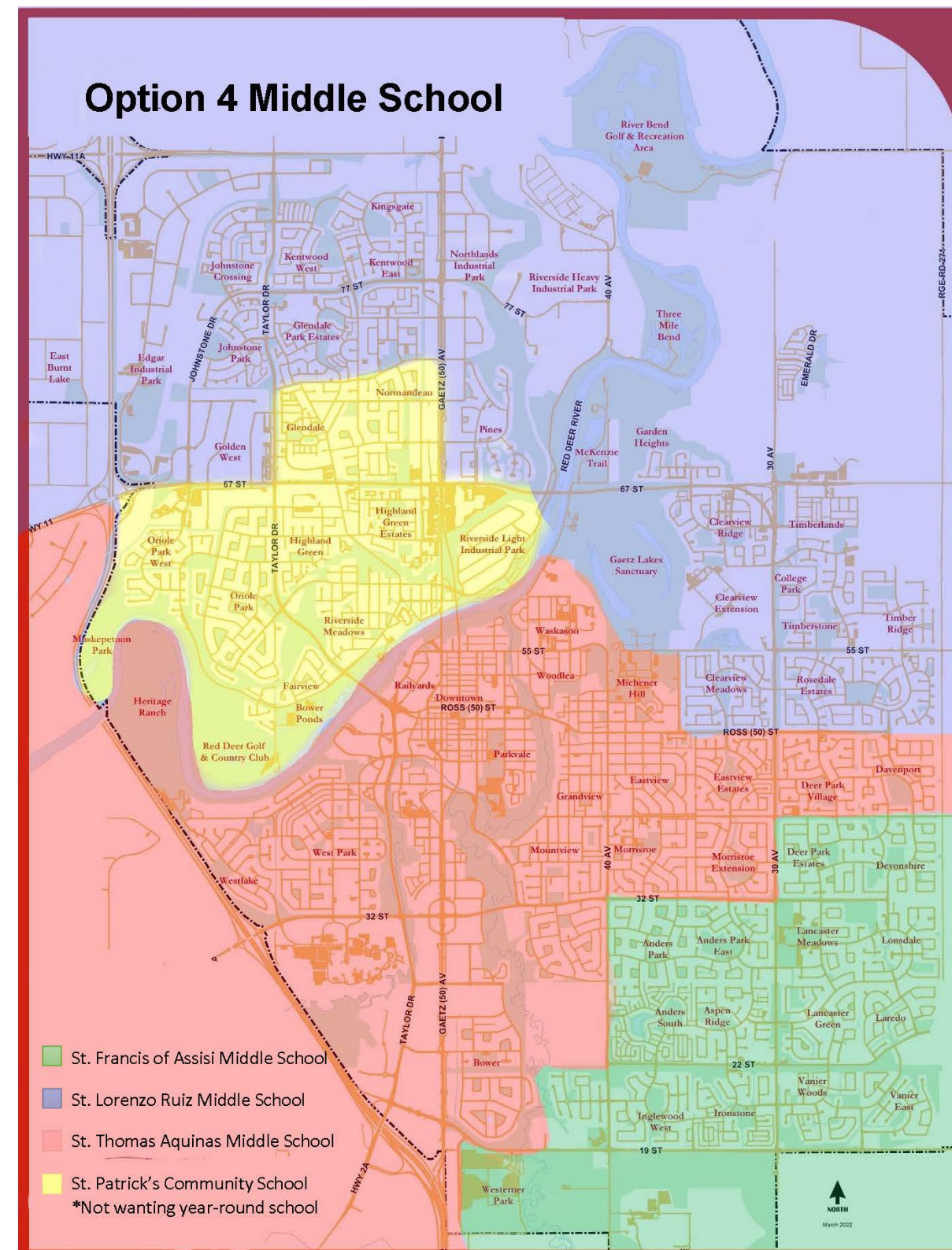

CONS:

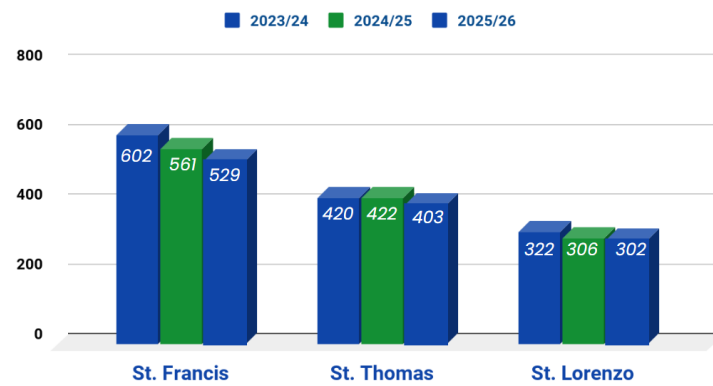
- No leapfrogging.
- Longer ride times from Deer Park and Rosedale to St. Lorenzo.



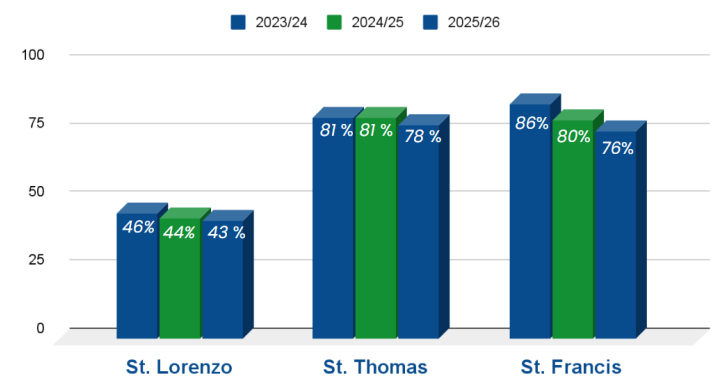

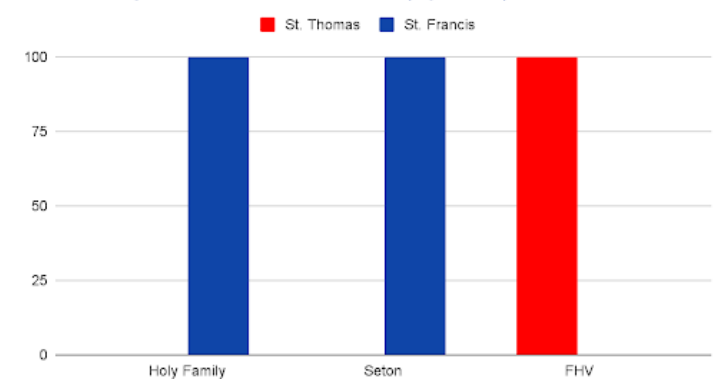
Option 5 Population Breakdown

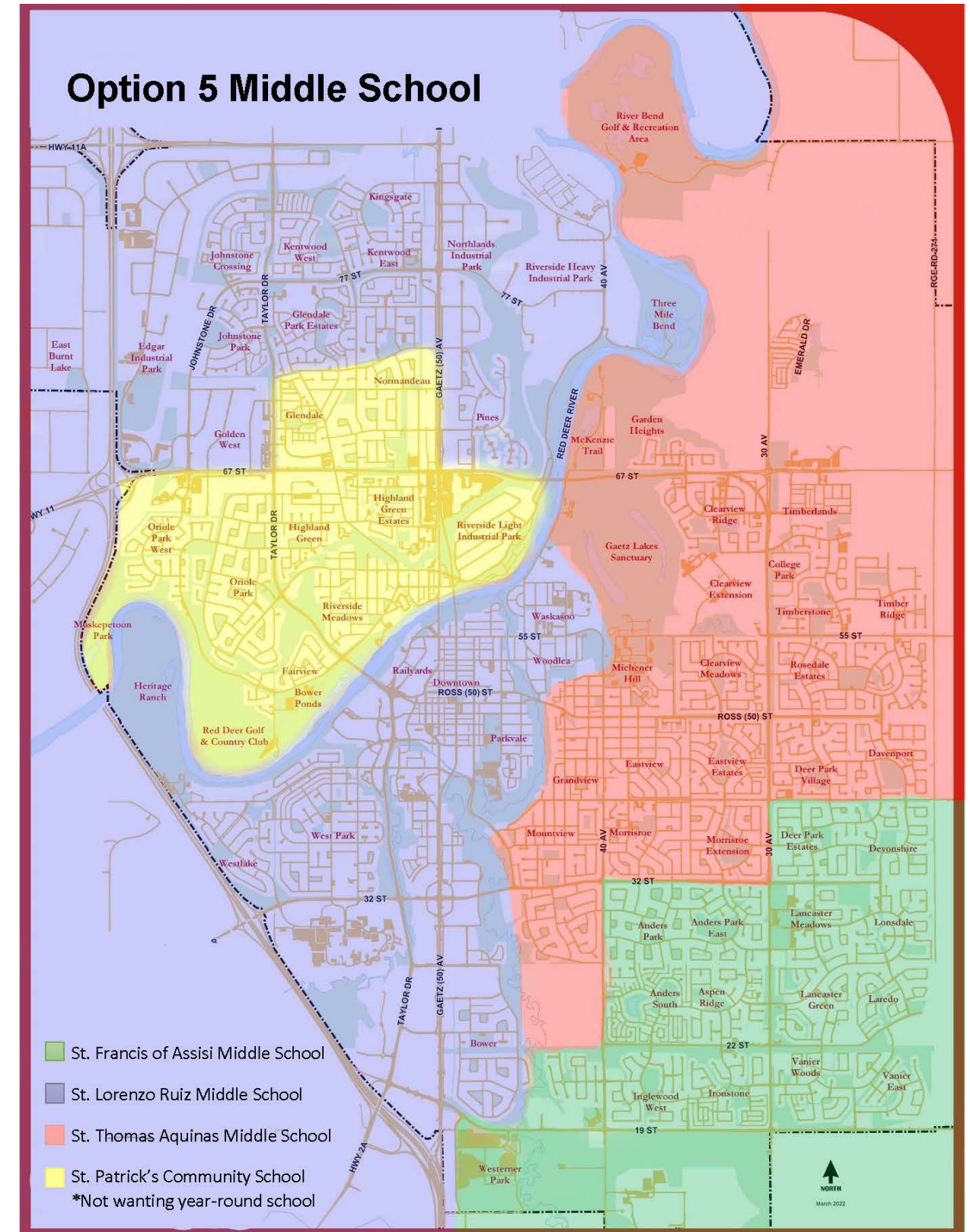

CONS:

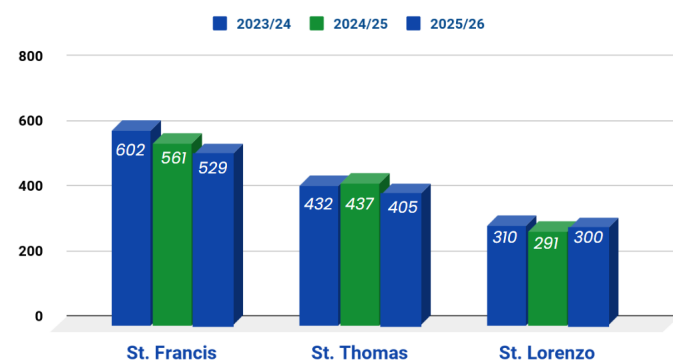

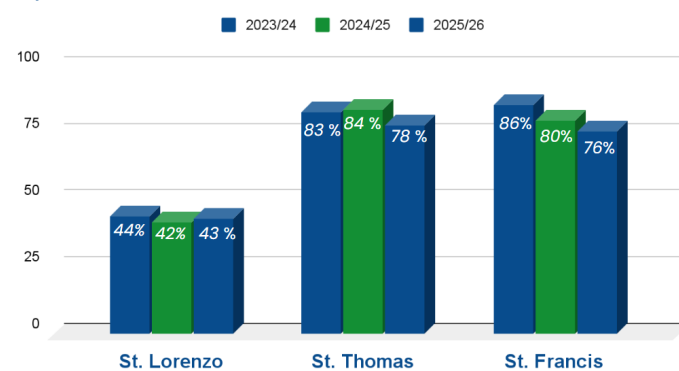

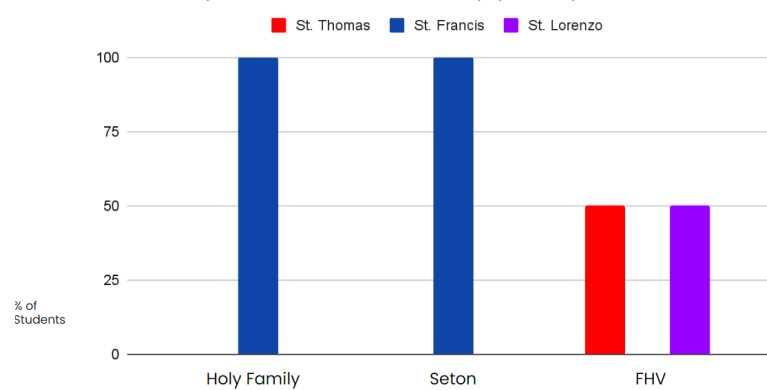
Option 6 Population Breakdown
