Division Budget Approval:

The Board of Trustees approved the 2024-2025 budget as presented by the Secretary-Treasurer. The approved budget is balanced and includes a slight decrease in projected enrolment. Trustees had a lengthy discussion around the administration of school fees. Significant adjustments have been made to balance the budget with both enrolments and staffing levels being estimated conservatively. The budget includes expansion to reflect the revised distance criteria in the new transportation model, which has created considerable uncertainty in both budgeted revenues and expenditures for the transportation department.

The Board of Trustees was updated on the objectives and partnerships within the Central Alberta Collegiate Institute model. The Associate Superintendent of Curriculum highlighted that Red Deer Catholic students are participating in pre-employment opportunities in Olds College and Red Deer Polytechnic and RDCRS is looking at the development of curriculum and career education models for students in grades 5-9 to align with students when they are at a critical stage.
