Capital Projects Updates

St. Marguerite Bourgeoys Catholic School

The school started the year in their new space. There are still some deficiencies to fix and work continues on repairing the roof. Phase 2 of John Wilson Elementary School is well under way and the final phase is expected to start in early November. This phase also includes the last classroom and library/learning commons at St. Marguerite Bourgeoys Catholic School.

St. Gregory the Great Catholic School

The exterior block and metal siding has begun. Floor grinding has started on the upper floor and interior walls will be following shortly. Site work has begun and expecting to have paving completed in the next few weeks.

St. Joseph High School

The interior painting is progressing. Installation of millwork has begun along with the elevator install. The final parking lot paving is scheduled for this week and landscaping continues.
